Mohammed Ibn Musa Al Khawarizmi was born in 780 in Baghdad, in the Arab Empire. This country is called now Iraq. Mohammed liked Maths and he learned a lot about Maths from the Indians an Greeks. He wrote a famous book called Kitab Al-Jabr Wa Al Muqabalah, which explained the idea of zero. Many people all over the world read this book and learned new things about Maths. Today, in many countries like the USA, Britan, Italy and Australia, people use the Maths they learned from Al-Khawarizmi. Al-Khawarizmi died in 850
