



* <u>NOTE</u>: In WRITING ^Y, test-writers actually have <u>two</u> different task-options to choose from (*Picture Story* or *Task Instructions*) when preparing the exam-paper. However, as both of these require student to produce a *narrative* text, the same Rating Scale can be used, whichever type of task they use.
