٣	 Manages to communicate some relevant information about the picture, but only in a limited way. There are several very noticeable language errors.
۲	 Attempts to communicate, but only with difficulty. Important points are missing or unclear. Frequent language errors.
١	 A very unsatisfactory attempt at the task. Very little is communicated. Language is seriously flawed.
